



TIKI TORCH STAND

INSTRUCTIONS



NOTE: THIS PRODUCT IS TO BE ASSEMBLED AND TESTED BY A QUALIFIED GAS FITTER ONLY.

- 1) Remove and un-package all products and check with the attached list to make sure all items were shipped and in good order. Any damaged goods should be reported immediately before proceeding with assembly.
- 2) Place the base on a flat surface for easy assembly.
- 3) Hand Tighten the 1/4" black machine set screws into base pipe supports from the package.
- 4) Separate the 6 pipes and put the 3/4" plain end pipes into the base pipe supports. The pipe should fit loose, and bottom out on the base plate.
DO NOT TIGHTEN SET SCREWS AT THIS TIME.
- 5) Remove wrapping from the hub and Hand Tighten the 1/4" black set screws into the hub.
- 6) Put the hub onto the three pipes on base.
TIGHTEN SET SCREWS.
- 7) Put pipe dope on the First Three Threads only of the 3/4" threaded pipes.
- 8) Thread the pipes into the hub, being careful not to cross the thread on starting.
- 9) Use a strap wrench to tighten the gas piping into the hub.
- 10) If you are using a propane tank, fasten the hose end of the hose/regulator assembly onto the 1/4" flare fitting in the hub.
- 11) If you are connecting directly on to a convenience outlet, connect a 10' 3/8" hose assembly to the flare fitting in the hub. Install the plug end of the convenience outlet to the other end of the hose assembly. Tighten all set screws.

NOTE:

All joints must be soap tested for leaks. A light solution of dish detergent works well for this purpose. A CERTIFIED GAS FITTER MUST ASSEMBLE THIS STAND AND TEST FOR LEAKAGE, BEFORE CERTIFYING FOR USE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

NOTE:

BEFORE TIKI TORCHES ARE LIT CARE MUST BE TAKEN TO ENSURE CLEARANCES FROM ALL COMBUSTIBLES ARE ADEQUATE, AS PER LOCAL CODES.

NOTE:

BLACK ENAMEL TOUCH UP PAINT SHOULD BE USED AT THE END OF EACH SEASON TO KEEP THE STAND FROM CORRODING, ESPECIALLY THE THREADS THAT ARE EXPOSED. INDOOR/DRY STORAGE IS RECOMMENDED FOR WINTER MONTHS
